The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.

7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.

- The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of 8
- The number of sections in the school are restricted to 32 as per number of sections reported by the IC and shall not be increased without specific approval of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall 0 apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of affiliation bye laws.
- The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
- The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting. segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc.

- The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/upgradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
- Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- The Manager and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.

- * Not found satisfactory. Boundary Wall is not completely constructed. School has stated that it will be completed soon. Playground area video has not been sent. Hence, School is required to complete entire Boundary wall from all sides of the school campus covering school building and playground area, within 2 months from the date of issue of this letter and play ground area should be developed and maintained as per norms. School is further required to keep all the records/videos/documentary evidence of completion of entire boundary wall and playground area of the school in the school records for future verification and submit the same to the Board as and when asked for.
- * 1. As per previous grant letter dated 12-12-2014, school was asked to submit comments, reply against the complaint letter dated 18-06-2012. School reply in this regard is still awaited. Hence, grant of extension is subject to final outcome of complaint against school. School is further required to keep all the records in connection with complaint with it, for future verification and to submit the same as and when asked for 2. SPECIAL CONDITIONS: extension is granted subject to condition that the school shall maintain record of certificate, compliance, data and other records/information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board and appropriate Government Authorities when asked for School shall be held responsible for genuineness of information / documents / data submitted, if found otherwise the school shall invite liable for suitable action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018.
